

About Your Portrait Sitting

Your session includes:

- Professional, well lit head shot/portrait using studio lighting and digital SLR camera
- Up to a thirty minute sitting (1 outfit)
- Proofs file (PDF) delivered by email
- Standard post-production retouching of 1 pose, your choice *
- 2 files in JPEG format with suitable resolution for 1) Internet 2) High resolution printing

** Standard post-production retouching is defined as color correction, cropping, light blemish and stray hair removal and light skin smoothing. (Removing 10 years or turning the subject into a supermodel is not included. It is important that the subject retains a 'natural' appearance appropriate to their age.) Complex retouching is available for an additional charge.*

Payment required at conclusion of sitting.

Tips for your sitting

Clothing guide

- Wear something appropriate for the intended use of your photograph.
- No busy patterns, stripes, plaids. Applies to men's ties also. (Solid color ties are best)
- No extra bright colors. Solid mid-tone colors are best. Black is ok.
- Long sleeves are best.
- Wear something you feel good in.
- Bring a second/third outfit as a backup.
- Will you be wearing a uniform, branded apparel, lab coat, etc. What color?

Women

- Wear clothing that shows minimum bare skin. We want to focus on your face.
- Keep makeup simple and natural looking.
- Be sure to smoothly blend your makeup from face to neck to chest.
- Be sure to bring makeup with you in case it is needed.
- If you would prefer to have a makeup/hair stylist present, we can try to arrange that for additional fee. If you have a friend/relative who can do that, consider bringing her.
- Keep Jewelry simple and appropriate for your outfit and the intended use of the photograph. Jewelry can be very reflective and distracting.

Men

- Be sure to shave. (Unless you are going for a specific unshaven look)
- Please be sure your nose and ear hair is trimmed!
